Join AROSC and NCRC at Mazda Laguna Seca Raceway for a great driving experience. We have an opportunity to share this event with NCRC at 105 db levels. Laguna Seca is a hard track to get, so don't miss this

opportunity. Please sign up EARLY as they will fill up fast.

We have lots of run groups, including Time Trial/Time Attack, and wheel-to-wheel racing. You will get about 2 hours of track time each day. Run groups will be limited to 35 cars maximum, and we will likely sell out some run groups!

#### The Run Groups will be assigned by NCRC. They are basically as follows

- **Time Trial Groups:** Your chance to achieve your best lap times at Laguna Seca. Controlled passing in specific sections of the track, or with a point-by. Based on your experience and car, we will assign you to the proper run group.
- Race: Wheel to wheel racing action. Experienced drivers only! If your car is OK to race with VARA or other sanctioned race series, then it is OK to race with AROSC.

NOTE: AROSC always requires a Fire & Rescue team at our events. If and when you need them, every second counts!

#### <u>Laguna Seca Policy Regarding Incident Damage to Track</u>

Facility Incidents: all participants will be responsible for any fees charged by WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca that arise as a result of any incidents, including damage to track facilities/barriers, fluid cleanup, or other.

  - b. increased compression from factory spec,
  - c. an engine swap to a more powerful engine then factory original.
- 2. Tires which are
  - a. "R" rated by the manufacturer
  - b. advertised as "track" or "race" tires, or which have a wear index less than 200.
- 3. Any car which has been lightened by 50 or more pounds from the original factory weight.
- 4. Any car which is not registered for street operation or which is not street legal

I understand that my entry fee is **NOT REFUNDABLE**. I understand that this event is governed by the **AROSC Competition Code**.
